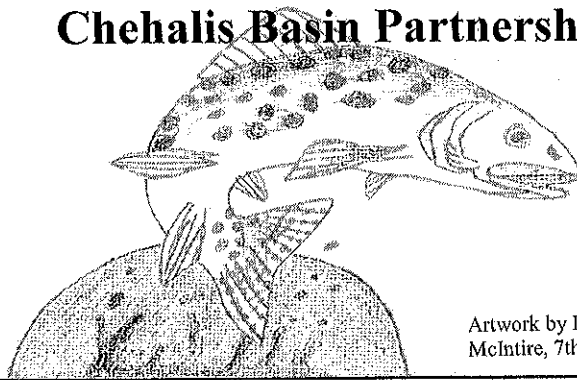


## **Chehalis Basin Partnership**
